- A copy of your official transcript and/or other official documents of your complete undergraduate and graduate school record.
- At least three written recommendations.
- A personal statement (no longer than four pages). Your personal statement should be narrative giving a brief profile of yourself, your professional development, and your interest in becoming an Island Institute Fellow.
