Broadband Internet Is a Public Utility at 25+Mbps Minimum (FCC) As Essential as Electricity & Clean Water. Especially for Rural Populations.

Islesboro Internet Access:

Quality Varies Greatly Location to Location

- 72+% Use 1-5+Mbps DSL \$
- 9+% Use Cellular 25+Mbps \$\$\$
- Nearby Mainland Has Cable 25+Mbps \$\$
- Too Small a Market for Corporate Investment

• Unlikely to Improve Absent a Town Investment








How Does the Town Pay For It?



Town Budget – Now to Full Operation


